### STATUTORY INSPECTION OF ANGLICAN AND METHODIST SCHOOLS – (SIAMS)

Following our SIAMS inspection on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2024, we are now able to share with you the Inspector's findings.

The SIAMS inspection plays an important role in the improvement of church schools. It achieves this by affirming that which is effective and by highlighting key areas of improvement. By focusing on impact, SIAMS explores ways in which each school's theologically rooted Christian vision drives the work and enables the school to live up to its foundation as a church school.

The new 2023 SIAMS framework highlights and seeks understanding of the theology which underpins a school's Christian vision.

We are delighted to share the inspection findings. After evaluating the evidence the Inspector has awarded the school Judgement 1 (the inspection findings indicate that the school is living up to its foundation as a Church school).
